Requirements of SARS-CoV-2 PCR tests and quarantine regulations for passengers who will travel to Turkey:

"Starting from 3 September 2021 21:00 UTC hours:

1) Passengers arriving from Bangladesh, India and Pakistan shall submit a negative PCR test result done within 72 hours before arrival. Passengers arriving directly from Bangladesh, India and Pakistan and passengers who had been in these countries within the last 14 days will be exempted from quarantine if they submit proof of two doses of vaccination (*listed by WHO or Turkey for emergency use, 1 dose for Johnson & Johnson*) provided that the last dose was at least 14 days before arrival. Otherwise, the passengers will be quarantined at their residences or addresses they submit. On the tenth day of quarantine, a PCR test will be done and if result is negative, quarantine will be lifted.

2) The requirements are not applicable to transit and/or transfer passengers.

3) There will be no PCR requirement and quarantine for the crew.

4) Passengers aged under 12 are exempted from PCR test report and vaccine certificate application on entry to the Republic of Turkey."
